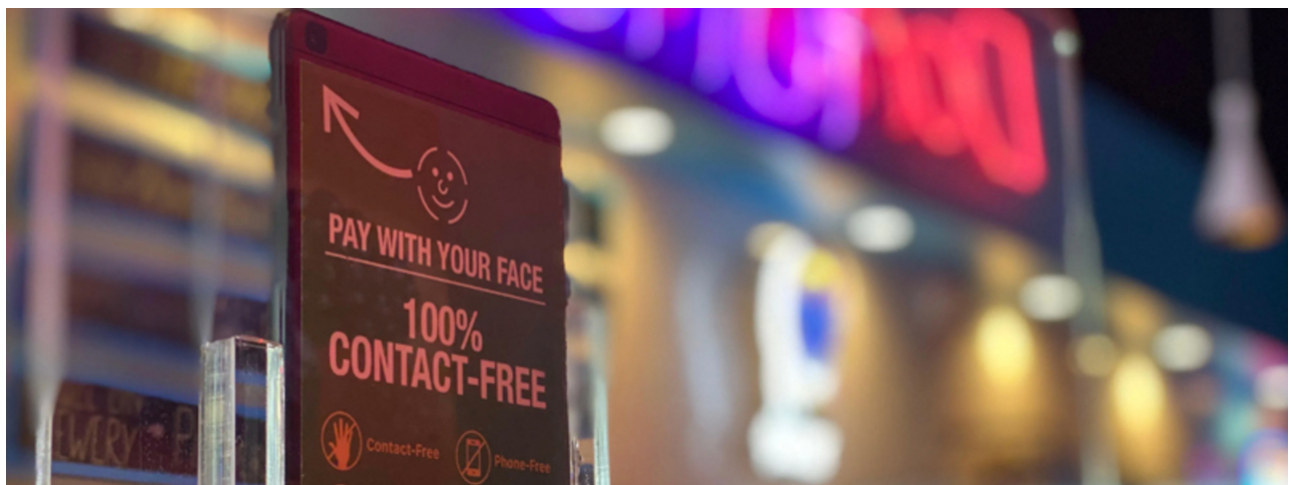
PlayhouseLive – Now Streaming

USC Pacific Asia Museum is hosting a free Conversations@PAM event on Saturday, October 17 at 2:30PM.
